




Sorting Flights






Michelle can also sort flights by airline, take-off and landing times or the total duration of the flight.




On the left side of the screen, Michelle can pick other options, such as only looking at Non-Stop flights.




She can also choose to look at flights with certain take-off times.




She can choose to leave from specific airports.




And choose to fly with specific airlines.




To view more details on a flight, Michelle can click on the show details link.
