



Adding New Apps



You can add new apps to your mobile device. To add new apps on any Android device, visit the Play Store. You can browse Featured Apps, look through categories, or search for an app by name.

Let's look for a Dictionary app. I tap the search box, then beginning typing. Automatic suggestions begin to appear below the search box as I type. I'll tap to choose "dictionary."






There are many apps to choose from. Some of them are free, and others cost a few dollars. We can tap any app to see details, pictures, and reviews.

Free apps often have advertisements, and some may have "in-app purchases" which means you have to pay to use certain features.


App purchases will usually get charged to your Google Account.





To install this app, I'll tap "Install." Once the app downloads, it will appear on your home screen.






Many apps have regular updates. These may add new features, fix problems, or increase security.

You can update your apps from the Play Store. Tap the button that looks like three horizontal lines to access the menu. Tap "My Apps and Games" and then choose "Update All." Most app updates are free.





To remove an app, locate it on your device, either from the home screen or the apps screen. Press and hold your finger on the app. Soon you'll see a menu of options appear. Here, I'll tap to choose the option to "Uninstall" which will delete the app from the device. When asked to confirm the uninstall, I'll tap "OK." The app is then deleted from the device.
